



**INCORPORATED VILLAGE OF MINEOLA – DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC WORKS
SOLID WASTE COLLECTION SCHEDULE**

Monday:

General Solid Waste Collection:

Route A – South Side of the Village and Commercial Areas

Yard Waste Collection:

Entire Village

Limit of 10 Items, not to exceed 250 pounds

(Branches or limbs must be cut and tied in 4 foot long bundles)

Tuesday:

General Solid Waste Collection:

Route B – North Side of the Village and Commercial Areas

Recycling:

Glass, Metals and Plastics Entire Village

White Goods/Metal:

Appliances are collected on Route B - North Side of Village

2 Appliance Limit (i.e.: Refrigerators (Door Off), Dish Washer, Clothes Washing Machine, Clothes Dryer, Computers & Printers, Lawnmowers (without fuel), Microwaves, Televisions)

Wednesday:

General Rubbish Collection:

Entire Village

Limit of 10 Items (other than metal), not to exceed 250 pounds

(i.e.: Sofa, Chair, Mattresses, Tables, Beds, etc.)

Thursday:

General Solid Waste Collection:

Route A – South Side of the Village and Commercial Areas

Recycling:

Newspaper – Entire Village (placed in recycling pail or tied in bundles)

White Goods/Metal:

Appliances are collected on Route A - South Side of the Village

2 Appliance Limit (i.e.: refrigerators (with door(s) off), dishwasher, clothes washing machine, clothes dryer, lawnmower (without fuel), microwave oven, television, etc.)

Friday:

General Solid Waste Collection:

Route B – North Side of the Village and Commercial Areas

Other Collection Items:

Collection of Leaves: Seasonal Collection

10 Bag Limit per Collection Day

Total weight not to exceed 250 Pounds

Collection of Cardboard: Collected as necessary in Commercial Areas

Definition of 10 Item Limit: Any combination of the following items:

Garbage Pail, Plastic Bag, Tied Bundle or Single Item (i.e.: Chair, Washing Machine, etc)

**Residents are reminded that all materials for collection must
be placed at the curb by 7:00 a.m., each collection day**
